Barcelona and the ETSAB Archive" proposes a parallel route to the development of the thematic workshop "Project and Memory" based on the conceptual analysis of both built and drawn architectures. In the current era, the case studies seek to bridge the gap between the tangible and the conceptual, offering students a deeper understanding of the materiality of architecture, its techniques, and the various registers in which it manifests. This is particularly relevant in light of the 150th anniversary of the Barcelona School of Architecture, which provides an opportunity to re-examine the legacy of its archive from new perspectives and methodologies.
